Welcome to the Club

The Howick Club is a large, modern facility set in landscaped grounds, with a membership base of over 4000, coming from all walks of life.

The Club places particular emphasis on family participation, with a large children's play area, which includes an 80 meter flying-fox.

As part of Clubs New Zealand network, our members enjoy reciprocal visiting rights with over 300 clubs within New Zealand and throughout Australia.

Our restaurant is open daily with an extensive A La Carte menu, Sunday Buffet dinner, and a variety of bar snacks.

The Club provides a secure, safe and friendly environment for members to enjoy with a regular programme of live entertainment, special children's events, indoor sports, special interest sections and function rooms for hire ... There's something here for everyone.



Club Facilities

The Howick Club has excellent facilities for our members and their guests to use.

Sports Bar

There are dart boards, pool tables and snooker tables available to use. There are also several big screen TVs to enjoy all the sporting action on Sky.

Lounge Bar

This offers a more laid back environment to enjoy quiet conversation.

Restaurant

The restaurant is open Monday to Sunday where you can relax and enjoy a great meal.

TAB

We offer a fully serviced TAB terminal and a Self Service Pod for your convenience, and also TVs for live viewing of races.

Gaming Room

The Club has 18 Gaming Machines, all operated by notes or Club gaming cards.

Function Rooms

There are rooms available to hire for functions catering from 50-200 guests.

ATM , EFTPOS and CREDIT CARD

The club offers an ATM located in the foyer, and also Eftpos and Credit Card facilities are available at the bar for purchases only.

Credit card transactions incur a 2.5% surcharge.



Club Membership

The Club offers the following memberships:

Full Member

Full members enjoy full use of the Club facilities, may stand for Executive Committee and may attend and vote at the AGM.

Social Member

Social members shall be the legally married spouse and/or the common law spouse of an existing Ordinary or Life Member.

Youth Member

Youth members shall be sons or daughters of full members and must be between the age of their 18th and 24th birthdays.

Social Members and Youth Members will have no voting rights, will not be eligible to stand for Executive Committee and will not be allowed to attend any AGM or Extra-Ordinary General Meeting. They will also not be eligible to represent the Club in competitions.

Super Membership

Members who have been full members of the Howick Club for more than 5 years or joined before 1 July 2015, will qualify for the superannuation discount at 65 years of age.

Affiliated Member

An affiliated member is someone who is a member of a club that is affiliated to Clubs New Zealand Inc. Clubs New Zealand is the leading association for clubs in New Zealand. They represent more than 300 clubs across the country including chartered clubs, community clubs, cosmopolitan clubs, workingmen's clubs, sports clubs and RSAs.

Member's Guests

Who needs to sign in?

Anyone who does not hold a Howick Club membership card and is over the age of 18 must be signed in. This includes members partners.

Howick Club Members are permitted to sign in up to a maximum of 5 guests per member. Should you wish to bring in a larger party, then please contact the office prior to your visit. The member is responsible for the guest and their behaviour in the club.

It is the responsibility of the member that all their guest have been signed in. If the member leaves then all their guest must leave too. This is due to liquor licencing laws around the clubs liquor licences. Failure to do could affect the members membership as it could impact on the Howick Club having a liquor licence. So it is taken very seriously.

Affiliated members must sign themselves and their guests in. They can sign in a maximum of 3 guests.

Guests are required to carry a visitor chit with them whilst on the premises. They will be required to produce it each and every time they go to the bar.

Affiliated Members are required to have their current membership card with them and produce it when requested by Club staff.

Sign-in chits are available at reception in the entrance foyer.

All Guests over 18

Must have their sign-in chit on them whilst on the premises

Private Functions Room Hire

(Minimum 50)

For large groups we are required to apply for a special licence which takes one month to get.

It is the responsibility of the member that all their guests have been signed. Failure to do so could affect their membership.

This is to comply with our liquor licence condition's.

General Information

Transfers

Any current member of a club affiliated to Clubs NZ who is residing in the Howick area and has been a member of another affiliated club for at least:

- 1 year (outside the Greater Auckland area)

- 3 years (within the Greater Auckland area)

shall be entitled to apply for transfer of membership to the Howick Club, provided that a transfer form has been received from the affiliated club.

Transfers will not be accepted from any club which is situated within a radius of 7km from the Howick Club.

No transfer will be accepted from any affiliated member who joined another club whilst residing in the Howick area and was eligible at that time to join the Howick Club.

Dress Code

A reasonable standard of dress is required at all times in the Lounge Bar, Restaurant and after 7pm in the Sports Bar.

The following attire is NOT permitted at any time:

- No Dirty or Torn clothing

- No Singlets or Tank Tops (Men only)

- No Offensive T-Shirts

- No Dirty Work Boots or Overalls

- No Hats (Men only)

Clean and tidy footwear must be worn at all times.

Taxi Chits and Taxi Phone

Taxi Chits are available to members for their journey home should the need arise.

The Taxi Phone for booking a taxi is located at reception in the foyer. Lift the handset and it will automatically book a taxi.

Breathalyser

A breathalyser unit is located in the sports bar. If you are in doubt, check your level to make sure you are okay to drive. Please wait 20 minutes after your last drink before using the unit, to ensure a correct reading.

Car Park Security

The Club carpark is locked at the end of each night. The gates will be opened for collection of vehicles from 7.30am Monday to Sunday. Please note the Howick Club is closed Christmas Day and the gates will be locked all day. The speed limit in the car park is 10km.

Children in the Club

We request that children 10 years and under vacate the **Howick Club** by 9pm, unless attending a pre-arranged private function.

Children's Birthday Parties

All children's birthday parties **MUST** be prearranged through the functions manager more than a week prior to the party. Sorry but the only food that can be brought into the club is a birthday cake. All beverages must be purchased from the bar.

Saturdays & Sundays 11am – 2pm only in Lower Lounge

Parties must be cleaned up by 2.30pm

Kids Disco Days 2.30-5.30pm – Parties only In the Function Room –

You can set up for your party from 1.30pm when you have prearranged it with the function manager.

Club Safe Policy

The following information describes the procedures and policy that this Club has adopted with respect to financial transactions.

The purpose of this policy is to create an environment in which members are encouraged to act responsibly in relation to their financial transactions as they relate to gambling activities at the Club.

Credit

Cash advances to members will not be provided for any purpose, e.g. “IOUs” will not be accepted in exchange for cash for any purpose.

Cash will not be provided at EFTPOS facilities where a “credit” transaction is involved.

Credit transactions will only be available for the purchase of goods and services such as meals, functions, tickets for shows, and members joining fees and subscriptions.

Cheques

Only financial members of this Club may cash a cheque. The maximum value a cheque will be cashed for at this Club is **\$500**.

Cheques will not be cashed where the money is to be used for the purpose of gaming or gambling.

Only one cheque per day to be cashed.

As of the 1st of April 2020 the Howick Club will no longer be accepting cheques for payments or cashing.

Howick Club By-Laws

1. PERSONS under 18 years are not permitted in the Sports Bar and Gaming Areas.
2. PERSONS under 18 years must be under Parental or Guardian control at all times.
3. ANY PERSON who has been suspended or banned from other Licensed Premises will NOT be allowed on the Club premises.
4. VISITORS must be signed in. The host member is responsible for visitors conduct and visitors must vacate the Club when the member leaves.
5. MEMBERS and affiliates shall produce their membership cards on demand.
6. DRESS - A reasonable standard of dress is required at all times.
 - No dirty or torn clothing • No singlets, tank tops (men)
 - No dirty boots or overalls • No offensive tee shirts
 - Clean and tidy footwear must be worn at all times
 - Jandals are not permitted in the Restaurant
7. ANY PERSON caught using or in possession of drugs on Club premises (other than prescription drugs) is liable to immediate expulsion.
8. THREATENING OR ABUSIVE BEHAVIOUR is unacceptable for any Member, Visitor or Staff on Club premises.
9. VIOLENT BEHAVIOUR will not be tolerated on Club premises and the Police will be called.
10. OFFENSIVE or foul language involving Members, Visitors or Staff will not be tolerated on Club premises.

Howick Club By-Laws

11. SEXUAL HARASSMENT is legally and socially unacceptable and will not be tolerated by Members, Visitors or Staff.
12. RACIAL HARASSMENT is illegal in NZ and will not be tolerated by Members, Visitors or Staff.
13. INTOXICATION - Members and Visitors who are intoxicated or showing signs of intoxication will not be served alcohol and will be asked to leave. It is against the Law.
14. NO LIQUOR (other than off licence purchases) or Club property to be removed from the Club premises.
15. ONLY LIQUOR that is purchased from the Howick Club (excluding off licence purchases) may be consumed within the Club premises.
16. ANY PERSON found with alcohol purchased elsewhere will be asked to leave the Club premises immediately.
17. NO MEMBERS or Visitors shall procure liquor for a prohibited person or for any person who has been refused.
18. STANDING at the bars is not permitted.
19. SMOKING is only permitted in the designated areas of the Club premises.
20. MEMBERS and Visitors are to return all glasses, jugs and bottles to the glass laundry.
21. THERE shall be NO GAMBLING, raffles or petitions on the Club premises without the express approval of the Executive Committee.
22. MEMBERS and Visitors shall not park cars in an inconsiderate manner nor park cars in areas marked "No Parking" or on yellow lines.

Howick Club By-Laws

23. MEMBERS and Visitors entering and leaving the car park and grounds of the Club shall respect the privacy and quiet enjoyment of residents of neighbouring properties.

24. Any person who acts in any way prejudicial to the Howick Club and brings the Howick Club into disrepute may face disciplinary action.

25. MEMBERS who are alleged to have breached the Club By Laws, shall:

26. Bringing food into the club is not permitted apart from picnics on the Howick Club picnic day.

- FIRSTLY be required to attend with the Vice President, Executive Committee person and the General Manager to discuss allegations, and;
- SECONDLY, subsequent to the initial meeting, may be required to appear before the Club Disciplinary Committee. Your membership card is to be held by the General Manager, and all Club privileges will be suspended pending the decision of that committee, and shall continue in the event of an appeal, until the final appeal decision is notified.

IMPLEMENTATION OF THE ABOVE BY LAWS ARE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE GENERAL MANAGER, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE, AND NO DISCUSSION WILL BE ENTERED INTO.
